IMPORTANT NATIONAL INFORMATION REGARDING SCHOOL ATTENDANCE:

Important National Changes to Absence Penalty Notices. PLEASE TAKE THE TIME TO READ THE UPDATED NATIONAL CHANGE TO PENALTY NOTICES AND PROCEDURES FOR UNAUTHORISED ABSENCE. THIS APPLIES FROM AUGUST 2024. You may be aware that the Department for Education has recently announced national changes to penalty notices issued for unauthorised absence in term time. These changes will come into effect on 19^{th} August 2024. The changes to be aware of are: Penalty notices issued for offences that take place after 19 August 2024 will be charged at a new rate of £160 per parent per child. This can be paid at £80 if paid within 21 days. Any second penalty notice issued to the same parent for the same child within a rolling 3-year period will be issued at the rate of £160 to be paid within 28 days with no option for a discounted rate. The threshold at which a penalty notice must be

considered is set at 10 sessions (equivalent to 5 days) of unauthorised absence within a rolling 10-school week period. This may include absences as a result of arriving late after the register closes. The 10 school weeks may span different terms or school years. A maximum of 2 penalty notices may be issued to a parent for the same child within a rolling 3-year period, so at the 3rd (or subsequent) offence(s) another course of action will need to be considered (such as prosecution or one of the other attendance legal interventions). Only penalty notices issued for absences taking place after 19 August 2024 will count towards the above thresholds. A school week is any week in which a school meets at least once. Pupils who are late after 9.00am will receive a 'U' code which is classed as an unauthorised absence. Lates are classed as unauthorised absences and will count towards the fines.

The School Attendance Policy will be updated over the summer and will be displayed on our website when we return in September 2024.

School Meal Vouchers - Summer Term Holiday 2024:

The Department for Works and Pensions Household Support Fund (HSF) grant has been extended with further funding being made available to County Councils and Unitary Authorities in England to support those most in need this summer. The extended programme will run from 01 April 2024 to 30 September 2024 and will provide further support to households in the most need, particularly those including children and pensioners who would otherwise struggle with energy bills, food and water bills.

For families who are eligible for free school meals and in receipt of benefits, free school meal vouchers have been ordered for the next six weeks for the summer holidays. **This voucher is for £90.00 per child / £180.00 2 children etc.** If there is any possibility that you may think that you qualify for free school meals, it is really worth Checking. The process is easy and all it takes is a phone call. Call the Pupil Access Team at Lancashire County Council on 01772 531809 with your Name, Date of Birth and National Insurance Number.

Qualifying benefits:

- If you or your partner receive any of the following benefits you can apply for free school meals:
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no
- more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

Holiday Activities and Food Programme (HAF)— Summer 2024:

Lancashire County Council are issuing families who are in receipt of free school meals with E-vouchers to let them know they are eligible for a Holiday place for their child. This is a way of ensuring all families with eligible children know they can book a place and how to do it, but also that only eligible children or those identified as in need receive a funded place.

The vouchers have been sent to eligible families by e-mail or text on Wednesday 3rd July and will include a 16-digit unique code. This can then used to book a place, using the existing booking systems in each district. The emails to look out for area:
