Action required: School Communication:

As you know, our communication platform is changing to School Spider from 1st September. Only 44 families have signed up so far therefore please ensure you download the app and create your account BEFORE this date. We want to ensure that you receive all school communication so it is extremely important you do this.

September Opening:

When we return to school in September, the school gates will open at 8.40am and will close at 8.50am. Your child may arrive at any time within the 10minute window. Punctuality is an important life skill so please be on time every day. The end of the school day is 3.15pm and children are to be collected from the playground.

Uniform:

We return in WINTER uniform in September (page 28 of the School Prospectus). Black school shoes only, no trainers to be worn.

Jewellery must not be worn at school. It is important that ear-piercing is ONLY carried out at the beginning of the summer holidays, as earrings are not permitted to be worn at school.
