Thursday 6 th March	World Book Day 2025. We love reading at St Oswald's and that's why World Book Day means so much to us. The children are invited to come to school dressed as a book character for the day. All the children will be given a special World Book Day token to take home.
Thursday 6 th March	School Meal Promotion– 'We love Reading'. If your child is normally on packed lunches and would like to have a school meal on this date, please complete the attached slip and return to school no later than Tuesday 4 th March. Pupils who normally have a school meal will be automatically included in the promotion. Payment of £2.70 should be made through ParentPay please. The menu is Charlotte's Chicken or Quorn Goujons or Sherlock Holmes Sausage Roll with Mr Fox Fantastic Fries, Bertie Bott's Beans followed by Hungry Caterpillar Cupcake or Willy Wonka's Chocolate Mousse. Tuesday 11 th March	Vision Screening for children in Reception carried out by the NHS Lancashire Vision Screening Service. This is an OPT-OUT system. All children will have vision screening in school unless a reply slip is returned (letter sent home today, 13 th February).
Tuesday 11 th March	Y4 visit to Chester Zoo as part of their Geography Studies (letter issued 15 th January).
Wednesday 12 th March	Freddy Fit in school to promote healthy lifestyles with every class. This is being funded from our Sports Premium funding. Every child must have their PE Kit in school for this

event. **Tuesday 18th March** Reception visit to 'Bring Yer Wellies' Study Trip on Planting & Life Cycles (letter issued 30th January). Thursday 20th March School Meal Promotion-'Be Happy Day'. If your child is normally on packed lunches and would like to have a school meal on this date, please complete the attached slip and return to school no later than Tuesday 18th March. Pupils who normally have a school meal will be automatically included in the promotion. Payment of £2.70 should be made through ParentPay please. The menu is Hotdog with Smiley Face Potatoes & Vegetables or Vegetable Pasta Bake with Garlic Bread and Salad followed by Jelly & Ice Cream or Marble Shortbread. Friday 21st March Whole school Yoga & Mindfulness Festival. Each class will have a yoga session throughout the day which includes learning breathing techniques and practicing calming movements. PE kits are needed for this event. Tuesday 25th March Y5 visit to Judges Lodgings as part of their History Studies (letter issued 26th February).

Admin Reminders:

- A week's notice **must** be given in writing (preferably by email) if you wish your child to change from packed lunches to school meals, or vice-versa. This is normal school policy thank you for your co-operation.
- It is essential that your child's Parent Pay account is in credit for school meals and Early Bird's. Please may I remind you to check your child's Parent Pay account on a regular basis and top-up as necessary. The account MUST stay in credit at all times. Thank you for your co-operation.
- Check your child's bag on a regular basis to make sure you are not missing out on anything. Any letters issued are also put on the school website.

Absence (Illness):

If your child is absent for any reason during the term, please telephone the school before 9.30 am on the first morning of your child's absence. If we do not receive a message from, you will receive a telephone call from school to query the reason for your child's absence. This is a " $1_{\rm st}$ Day Contact" system and is part of our safeguarding procedure. On your child's return to school, please provide a letter or email the school office explaining the absence. If no explanation is received in writing, the absence will be deemed as unauthorised.

Absence (Medical/Dental Appointments, etc.) with Appointment Card:

Where possible, please try to make appointments out of school time. However, should you need to take your child out of school for an appointment, please provide school with a copy of the appointment card or letter at least two days in advance of the appointment. If an appointment card is not available, please write a note or email the school with the details of the appointment. Pupils should be collected from the school office. Please ensure that your child has been 'signed out" on collection. On your child's return to school, pupils must be brought to the school office and, again be 'signed in' by a parent, carer or family member. This is for health and safety and fire regulation purposes to ensure that all pupils are accounted for.

Free School Meals & Pupil Premium:

Free school meals are provided for all pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 as part of a Government Universal Grant initiative. However, for those pupils who have a statutory entitlement to free school meals, i.e. those pupils whose parents/carers are in receipt of the benefits mentioned below, the school can benefit from additional funding called Pupil Premium. The benefit entitlements are:

- Universal Credit with a household income of less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
- Income-Based Jobseekers' Allowance
- Income-Related Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit, not entitled to Working Tax Credit and household income less than £16,190
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Income Support
- Working Tax Credit 'run on' the payment you receive for a further four weeks after you finish work

If you think you meet any of these criteria, we do urge you to register. All you need to do is complete a simple form which is available from the school office or, alternatively, contact LCC on 01772 531809 and provide them with the claimant's (parent's) name, date of birth and National Insurance number and they will be able to confirm over the phone whether or not you are entitled
